Course Structure

The Nottingham Colonic School programme is designed for students who want to train properly, not rush through a weekend certificate. Students train with Jane Bush MACH RT through a structured 5-6 month professional pathway.

4 theory weekends

Structured teaching, guided reading and preparation.

8 practical training days

Hands-on clinical learning through Nottingham and Gedling clinic expertise.

15 supervised practical sessions

Supported progression towards professional practice.

Usually 3 students

Small-group training with closer tutor attention.



Requirements, Fees and Reserving

Entry requirements

Level 3 anatomy and physiology is the minimum requirement. First Aid, DBS and student insurance are also required. Jane may recommend additional bodywork or nutrition preparation depending on background.

Fees

The course fee is GBP 3,500. A GBP 500 non-refundable deposit secures your place once suitability is clear, with the GBP 3,000 balance due later under the current course terms.

Before you pay

If you are unsure whether you meet the requirements, complete the eligibility form first. Jane can review your background before you reserve.

After payment

Your payment is verified before the booking is treated as confirmed. Jane receives your details and your student dashboard shows next steps, payment history and balance information.
